## FRAGRANCE (& the solvent that suspends it)

Offgases for a long time.  
Fragrance offgases more when wet.  
Doesn't 'disappear a few hours after you put it on'.

## WEARING FRAGRANCE INTO THE ROOM

Will NOT 'just be ok'.  
WILL harm the health of the patient, increasing with each repeat exposure.  
Causes serious bronchial constriction.  
Constriction, despite treatment, will not stop until the allergen (source of the fragrance) is completely removed from the patient's environment.
